**Purpose:** To ensure that all parts for City Theatrical products are formed to the highest quality standards and completed in a timely fashion as dictated by standards for each part.

### **Team Member Responsibilities:**

- Set up and operate Amada press brakes using proper tools and methods
- Calibrate brakes daily before beginning production
- Choose tooling by studying part drawings
- Program CNC controls to achieve proper bending dimensions and tolerance
- Responsible for ensuring parts are manufactured to standards and specifications
- Works according to priorities as assigned by Production Scheduling
- Reports to Production Management of any equipment or tooling malfunctioning
- Maintains accountability for misused tooling or improper setups
- Maintains expected productivity output levels and completes assignments as scheduled
- Performs first piece quality check to verify piece meets manufacturing specifications
- Ensures product quality meets standards by frequently checking work
- Responsible for ensuring daily and monthly maintenance is completed and recorded
- Follows safety procedures, OSHA guidelines and wears PPE at all times
- Maintains a clean, organized and safe work environment
- Ensures after task is completed, floor is swept and tools are returned to designated area
- Organizes work area so that another person is able to locate information easily
- Conducts equipment and tools Preventative Maintenance
- Flexible to support other work center processes as dictated by production demand
