"We have not done an off-off Broadway musical in a long time. But lighting Broadway Bounty Hunter, starring Annie Golden, was too good of an opportunity to miss. The challenge to provide contemporary energized music-driven light in a miniature theater with no fly space and a wall only seven inches off stage right drew us in. If we

attached to this wall, pointed an ellipsoidal spotlight with a Top Hat straight on stage towards the performers, it meant taking away almost two feet from the acting space. We did not even bother to ask the director for we knew what the answer would be.

To the rescue: City Theatrical Beam Benders. By mounting the lamps vertically, we went from a two-foot intrusion to a barely noticeable 10 inches, wrapped in a tube of black duvetyn covered black wrap.

Working O-O Broadway doesn't have to mean giving up your Broadway aspirations. Come see the show, it is full of lighting surprises beyond this simple example, and it is GOOD!
